Climate Change Bill provisions for PCC

- PCC established as a Schedule 3 public entity which is independent and impartial
- President appoints not more than 25 Commissioners from government, organised labour, civil society, traditional leaders, SALGA and business
 - Based on public nominations
 - Ministers from relevant portfolios to be invited to attend meetings
- Function is to advise on SA's climate change response, including mitigation and adaptation, towards the attainment of the just transition to a low-carbon and climateresilient economy and society
- Five-year term for Commissioners, renewable for one term
- Commission can set up and delegate powers to committees, and adopts its rules and code of conduct, including rules for removal of Commissioners
- Minister appoints ED as accounting officer, who in turn appoints Secretariat
 - ED reports quarterly and annually to Minister in terms of approved business plan
 - Funding from national budget and grants in accordance with approved fundraising strategy
- PCC submits all its reports, studies, plans and recommendations to National Assembly annually and on request

Feasibility study

A feasibility study and business case has been prepared in consultation with NT, DFFE, DPME, DoEL and NEDLAC – in accordance with NT requirements for new entities

Organisational design

Costed organogram being prepared which includes all statutory functions – to be approved by Finance & Governance Committee

Funding

Submission made for next MTEF period; updated business plan to be prepared 2024; outreach to donors to meet funding gap

Establishment of the Just Transition Labour Centre

- Four South African trade union federations (COSATU, FEDUSA, NACTU & SAFTU) have come together to launch a just transition research centre
- The centre will develop the technical expertise to help the labour movement in addressing the potential risks posed to workers as a result of the restructuring that will accompany the transition to greater climate resilience.
- The centre will initially be housed at Trade and Industrial Policy Strategies (TIPS)
- Creation of the centre reflects labour movement's recognition that climate crisis entail ssubstantial economic and plant-level restructuring that would "inevitably impose significant burdens on working people".


