


Social Ownership of Renewable Energy




# Komati decommissioning

- Following PCC Komati report, Eskom has appointed implementing agency for Component C, and JETIP PMU and IDC have mobilised Social Employment Fund to create short term work opportunities
- PCC has initiated monthly meetings of Eskom, DPE, DFFE, Mpumalanga province, local government, donors and NGOs to align & coordinate activities
- At Minister Gordhan's suggestion, workstreams have been established for various activities and a reporting template developed
- PCC is planning to undertake a one-year review of progress in terms of PCC report recommendations

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Integrating JT into planning and programmes of government agencies and social partners

- Ongoing PCC engagement with mining sector on JT
- Detailed PCC research into employment, skills and finance for JT
- Discussions underway with NT on integrating JT into fiscal framework
- Through DPME, PCC has reviewed and commented on Departments' strategic plans and APPs
- PCC has also made input on JT to the Medium-Term Development Plan

Commission to consider how best to manage JT issues:

- Currently falls under Net-zero Working Group
- Should a new Working Group be established?
- Is a JT Implementation Plan still relevant?
- A follow-up workshop with National Planning Commission is proposed, at which MTDP for 7<sup>th</sup> Administration can be discussed amongst others

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#### Governance matters

Presidency has extended terms of five Commissioners whose terms were linked to 6<sup>th</sup> administration

Vacancies (Eskom & COSATU) to be filled by new administration Climate Change Bill approved by Parliament– PCC is engaging DFFE on implementation & regulations

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Feasibility study and business case for PCC as a public entity submitted to DFFE and NT

New organogram approved by Finance & Governance Committee and NEDLAC structures Staff to be migrated into permanent posts in new structure based on a change management process 3-year business plan to be approved at this meeting, & targets included in NEDLAC APP
