### **Impact**


 Influencing policy, promoting sustainable economic change, and providing advice in those areas where action falls short



# **Recap of PCC Strategic Plan**

### **Strategic Priorities over the next three years:**

- Establishing enabling conditions for implementation of a just transition;
- Ensuring the foundations are in place for longterm climate resilience and adaptation;
- Identifying and supporting net-zero pathways;
- Mobilising financial and technological resources to achieve a just transition;
- Ensuring that the PCC is **effective** in fulfilling its mandate and addressing the complex and systemic nature of the **climate transition**.





## **Outcomes from the Commissioner Retreat**

- There was a strong emphasis on clarifying roles and responsibilities to enhance team collaboration and organizational effectiveness.
- Commissioners recognized the impact of global economic and governance shifts and the need for South Africa to adapt.
- Stakeholder engagement and transparency were highlighted as critical for successful local implementation of climate initiatives
- A 5-year roadmap will be developed to align with global and local climate goals, focusing on industrialization, education, and healthcare.
- Lessons from the Komati Power Station transition will be applied to other coal-fired power plants nearing decommissioning.

- A framework for just transition projects will be created, including funding mechanisms and socioeconomic impact assessments.
- A need for clear public communication strategies was emphasized to distinguish personal opinions from official Commission positions.
- Climate resilience initiatives will focus on urban areas affected by climate migration, with potential special economic zones for climate projects.
- Biannual breakaway sessions will be held to strengthen team dynamics and improve strategic planning.


