

Youth Voices to COP28

CALLS TO ACTION:

- 1. We applaud the passing of the Climate Change Bill.
- 2. We urge that the GST outcome should reflect the need to transform food systems through the FAST initiative launched at COP27.
- 3. Call for enhanced service delivery within water-scarce communities following this year's UN Water Conference in New York.
- 4. Call for the commitment to source \$100 billion per year in climate finance by developed countries, as outlined in the Paris Agreement, to be met rapidly;
- 5. We advocate for the increased support of women and vulnerable communities' equal and meaningful participation in policy-making.
- 6. We urge for peace-positive adaptation and conflict--sensitising climate policy.



Plans & Expectations




- Advocate for and reinforce the inclusion and implementation of the first ever South African Youth Climate Action Plan (SAYCAP).
- 2. Follow up and contribute input to operationalizing climate finance related commitments.
- Co-host and moderate an educational and awareness sideevent at the 'Children and Youth Pavilion' on the 9th of December.

EXPECTATIONS

- Honest and concise conversations about the opportunities and pertaining the continent's position on carbon credit markets
- 2. Reforming and modernising the global financial system architecture between multilateral development banks, making it fit for purpose to support Sustainable Development as per President Ramaposa's emphasis at last year's COP27.
- Effective monitoring and evaluation system of the Global
 Goal on Adaptation (GGA) to be enhanced to strengthen mitigation resilience, and reduce vulnerability to climate change.
