About The Presidential Climate Commission

The Presidential Climate Commission was established by President Cyril Ramaphosa in 2020 to advise on the country's climate change response and pathways to a low-carbon, climate-resilient economy and society.

The first of these responses will be in the form of a Just Transition Framework in 2022 which will be a plan for achieving a just and equitable transition to net-zero CO₂ emissions in South Africa and set out the actions that social partners will take over the short-, medium, and long-run.

The Just Transition Framework presents an opportunity to start dealing with issues relating to governance mechanisms, economic diversification tools, labour market interventions, and social support.
